

MAY 1 TO BE 'LAW DAY'

President Urges Dedication
to 'Government Under Laws'

WASHINGTON, Feb. 4 (AP)—President Eisenhower today proclaimed May 1 as "Law Day" to provide a time of "national dedication to the principle of government under laws."

The President said that this would afford an opportunity for better understanding and appreciation of the manifold virtues of such a government and would focus the attention of the world upon them.

The proclamation said it was fitting that the people of this country should "remember with pride and vigilantly guard the great heritage of liberty, justice and equality under law."
